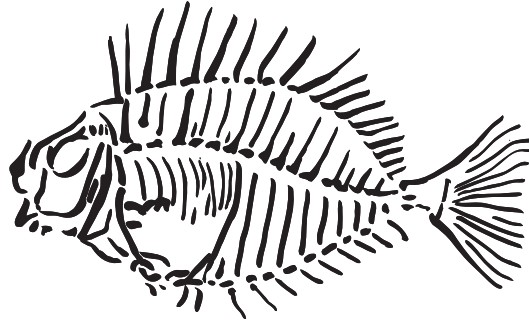
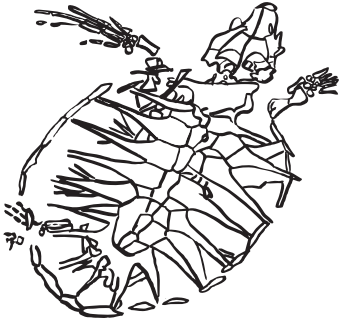


# STONY NATIVE GLARONIANS



The shales from Engi are well known in the whole world because of its unique fossils, „the Stony Native GLaronians“. They become presented in famous museums of natural sciences such as those in New York or Amsterdam. Beside a rich and multiform fish fauna with *Protosiganus glarisianus* as its most prominent representative, the shales contain also turtles (*Glarichelys knorri*), and a species of bird (*Protornis glaronensis*) that was a relative to the recent kingfisher. The Stony Native GLaronians were found in the ancient shale mine „Landesplattenberg“, not far from the recent factory buildings of the „Glarner Feingebäck AG“ in Engi.
